Medical Notebook for Signs and Symptoms in First Aid Box

Allow extra time when Calculating overall timings as things always take longer than expected

Remember to book in and out with Coastguard and update if going to be late back

A watch for the logging in and out of divers is always handy on the surface

Depth on Site - Chart Depth, plus height of tide

Tide Tables - Need to be for port of usage and check which time zone used (add 1 hr for BST)
