### Before Hand

Shore Cover via a mobile Phone	Shore Cover needs to know what to do in case of none return Add extra time for kitting up, swim back to shore and dekitting before action by cover. Cover needs to know cars, people and timings. Beware lack of mobile coverage in some areas

### Points to consider when Planning

High Tide timings – less walking.
